



NORTHWEST VENOM

Terms and Conditions

In consideration of being allowed (or my child being allowed) to participate in any way in Northwest Venom AAA Hockey and any other locations training or services are provided, related programs, leagues, tournaments, events and activities (collectively "Programs"), the undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate, and agree that:

1. The risk of injury from the activities involved in the Programs are significant, including the potential for personal injury, permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown of my participation (and the participation of my child) in Programs, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation (including my child's participation); and,
3. I understand that I (and my Child) must be in good health to participate in the Programs; and,
4. I (and my child) willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation in Programs. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself or Child from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
5. I, for myself and on behalf of my children, heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY FULLY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, FOREVER DISCHARGE AND HOLD HARMLESS NORTHWEST VENOM HOCKEY, its successors and assigns, their officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the Programs (collectively "Releasees" or "RELEASEES"), FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS AND DEMANDS OF WHATEVER KIND OF NATURE, EITHER IN LAW OR IN EQUITY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law. I also understand that Releasees do not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.
6. I understand and agree that this Agreement covers each and every Program in which I (or my child) participate in.
7. Upon registration for this program, I acknowledge and agree that I will be required to pay the entire registration fee of \$975 for the applicable program. \$325 of the \$975 will be due by October 15th, 2026. 2nd payment of \$400 will be due by January 1st, 2027, and remaining payment of \$250 due by March 1st, 2027. All payments are non-refundable.

8. BY REGISTERING YOURSELF OR CHILDREN FOR ANY PROGRAMS, YOU SIGNIFY YOUR AGREEMENT TO THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

I, the undersigned, do hereby consent and agree that the Northwest Venom, its employees, or agents have the right to take photographs, videotape, or digital recordings of me and to use these in any and all media, now or hereafter known. I further consent that my name and identity may be revealed therein or by descriptive text or commentary. I do hereby release to Northwest Venom, its agents, and employees all rights to exhibit this work in print and electronic form publicly or privately and to market and sell copies. I waive any rights, claims, or interest I may have to control the use of my identity or likeness in whatever media used. I understand that there will be no financial or other remuneration for recording me, either for initial or subsequent transmission or playback.

Tournament Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct applies to all players, coaches and spectators for any/all events including the Northwest Venom. By completing registration, players, coaches, parents, and spectators agree to abide by these guidelines or face consequences including; removal from the game or venue, suspension from the tournament, removal from the team and/or forfeiture of future participation:

- Sportsmanship: Players, coaches, parents and spectators must show respect to officials, opponents, teammates and staff. Unsportsmanlike behavior, such as taunting, fighting, disrespect of officials, bullying or virtual harassment will not be tolerated.
- Respect for Officials: Referees and officials deserve respect, regardless of game outcomes. Any harassment or interference with officials will never be allowed.
- Respect for Facilities: Treat all tournament facilities/arenas/rinks with care and respect, following all rules and respecting staff and volunteers.
- Spirit of the Game: Racial, religious, or gender related slurs will never be tolerated. Negative comments about others virtual or in person is unacceptable.
- Respect the Hotel: Participants are expected to treat hotel property with care and abide by all hotel rules. Damages caused to hotel property will be the sole responsibility of the offending person(s).
